Diamond Bar Ranch was honored to have been asked to host the 2022 National Grazing Lands Tour on September 9. The National Grazing Lands Coalition (NatGLC) Board of Directors joined together in North Platte earlier that week to discuss plans for the upcoming year. Kim Stine, Director of Development for NatGLC and former Stapleton resident, asked the Jones family to conduct the tour this year in Logan County. It was a wonderful opportunity to host land stewards from Utah, Pennsylvania, Missouri, Texas, Minnesota, Mississippi, Montana, Georgia, South Carolina, North Dakota, Florida, Louisiana, Colorado, Kansas, and Nebraska. Fifty plus people spent the morning touring the ranch on a bus and West Central Research & Extension center's people mover through the pasture. Time was spent talking about the history of the ranch, the Village of Stapleton, natural resources in the area, and an overview of management of the operation. Sandhill Catering provided the noon meal and members spent the remainder of the afternoon touring The Golden Spike in North Platte.

The National Grazing Lands Coalition is founded on the principles of voluntary action by those who own and manage grazing lands, and a respect for private property rights.

The NatGLC works with individuals from leading agricultural organizations across the country to establish local, state, and regional partnerships to foster grazing land conservation and stewardship.

The Nebraska Grazing Lands Coalition is comprised of ranchers and private landowners all focused on creating public awareness and improvement of the grazing lands in Nebraska. The organization's top focus is to provide voluntary technical assistance and educational opportunities on grazing land management.

"Our membership was elderly and others no longer live here and could not attend meetings," Carol Burgess, treasurer said. "It got down to four or maybe five people and we just could not continue any longer."

Additional 2022 officers

were Connie Santo, president; Katrina Frey, vice president; and Clara Ewoldt, secretary.

The local American Legion Auxiliary was the organizing sponsor of Cornhusker Girls State, coordinated and served lunch at Logan County Government Day, conducted the selling of Buddy poppies, and helped put on the Stapleton High School Veterans Day program.

The Auxiliary leaves a legacy of community service to veterans and residents over the years after a joint meeting of the Victor H. Peterson Post 324

and the Auxiliary was held November 23, 1933. Verne Taylor, District Commander of North Platte, was present to help organize an Auxiliary to the post.
