Mid-NE Community Foundation honoring legacy of Bob & Susan Childers

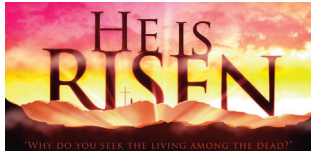
