Bikers Show Support For Local Farmer's Market

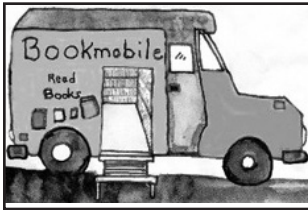
