

## SPS Foundation Banquet Fundraiser

**It was a new date, venue and menu, as the Stapleton Public School Foundation Banquet was moved to Friday, May 24 and held at the Logan County Fair Building.**

The long-term vision of the SPS Foundation is to grow the event to involve Stapleton High School Alumni. Several alumni members were on hand this year to hear Ruby Clark, a 1974 graduate of SHS, speak on her years since roaming the halls of the school.

Clark graduated from UN-L in 1977 and Washington University in St. Louis in 1979. She began working at Motorola in 1980 as a Process Engineer in the Semiconductors Product Sector.

Clark said she received an excellent education at Stapleton and credited teachers Bob Harvey and Gary Johnsen for giving her the foundation she needed to succeed as she received a Six Sigma Master Black Belt in the application and use of statistical methods.

"Since I have to change my passwords on a regular basis, I am using what I learned at SHS to come up with

new ones," Clark said. "Stapleton is 'home' regardless of where I'm working or visiting. Every place in the world that I've been to for work or pleasure has heard of Stapleton and the 'Good Life' in Nebraska."

She told how her dad always told her 'your job isn't done until the job is done.' This is why it's important to see tasks through to completion, regardless

of obstacles or setbacks.

Clark has traveled extensively outside the United States to Europe, Malaysia, Taiwan, China, Singapore and Thailand, and told of some experiences as she performed her duties overseas.

Stapleton FFA members, under the guidance of their advisor Dasie Nichols, served the prime rib meal prepared by Eric Frey

and helpers.

A number of silent auction items were available to bid on. Duane McClain, auctioneer and SPS Foundation president conducted the live auction.

At the end of the evening and tallies made, over \$26,000.00 was taken in to benefit Stapleton Public School students.
