Quote: "Compassion is a way of being." "We may not be angels, but we can be used by the angels."

Angels are beings created by God (Colossians 1:15-17) and are entirely different from humans. They are God's special agents to carry out His plan and to minister to the followers of Christ (Hebrews 1:13-14) There is no indication that angels were formerly humans or anything else. They were created as angels.

There is often confusion about what happens to the believer in Christ when they die. The spirit of the believer goes to be with Christ (2 Cor. 5:8). The believer does not become an angel. It is interesting that both Elijah and Moses were recognizable on the Mount of Transfiguration. They had not transformed into angels but appeared as themselves, although glorified, and were recognizable to Peter, James and John.

In 1 Thess. 4:13-18, Paul tells us that believers in Christ are asleep in Jesus; that is, their bodies are dead, but their spirits are alive. This text tells us that when Christ returns, He will bring with Him those who are asleep in Him, and then their bodies will be raised, made new like Christ's resurrected body, to be joined with their spirits which He brings with Him. All believers in Christ who are living at the return of Christ will have their bodies changed to be like

Christ, and they will be completely new in their spirits, no longer having a sin nature.

All the believers in Christ will recognize one another and live with the Lord forever. We will serve Him throughout eternity, not as angels, but along with and over the angels. Paul says that the future Kingdom of God will not be ruled by angels but by resurrected believers. 1 Cor. 6:3 illustrates this point. Paul says: "Know ye not that we shall judge angels? How much more things that pertain to this life?"

God has something better planned for us even more than angels, not because we are so great, but because we have been adopted into God's royal family.

People who die, young or old, don't become angels. Not everyone who

dies goes to heaven. Jesus says there would be few in Matthew 7:14. Someone may pray for you, but that someone cannot put you into heaven. You may join a church, but membership can't get you into heaven. Being baptized won't get you into heaven. A minister may speak at your funeral, but a minister can't preach you into heaven. Doing a lot of good things is great, but it won't gain you access to heaven. There is only one way for your journey on earth to end well. Jesus said, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." John 14:6. Repent of your sin, believe on Jesus, follow Him and leave this world clinging to Him in faith, knowing He has you in His hands. His grace is sufficient. Trust Him!
